Mr. Matuk's Report:

- Nassau County District Attorney Kathleen Rice will be speaking to parents and students in the PAC on 1/5/12 about Social Host Laws. Ms. Rice was featured on "60 Minutes" discussing the students paying someone else to take the SAT for them and will be coming to CSH HS immediately after her appearance on "The Today Show".
- Melissa Wayne, prevention coordinator for an addiction and recovery program will be speaking to the 11th grade students.
- New courses that will be offered next year:
 - o Applications in Web 2.0 (offered through the Social Studies Dept., Ms. Beach will most likely teach this course that will focus on Word, Excel, Powerpoint).
 - o AP Art History (offered through the Art Dept., open to all students grades 10-12)
- Next year all 9th grade students will be part of the Humanities Program. The students will be teamed with the same Social Studies and English teachers during back-to-back periods.
- Changes in the scheduling process: The petition process will be eliminated. Parents will receive a suggested schedule that the current teachers recommend for the following year. Parents should speak directly with the teacher if they disagree with the recommendation. Scheduling of classes will no longer be based solely on grades.
- Next year ALL 8th grade students will take Living Environment/Biology (the 8th grade accelerated science course currently being offered). All 8th grade students will take the Biology Regents at the end of next year; this will get one regents

exam out of the way before they enter high school.

Mrs. Cambria - Guidance Dept.:

- Mrs. Cambria suggests that the student should be involved in the conversation with the teacher and parent about Accelerated/Honors/AP courses.
- Course recommendations will be made at the end of the 2^{nd} quarter. The teacher will compute the grade and then make a recommendation.
- Guidance Counselors will begin to see individual students during the 3rd quarter, in decreasing order (11th graders will be seen first). It does not matter when your child sees their Guidance Counselor no classes will be assigned until every student has spoken to his/her counselor.
- Course Study book will be available ***ON LINE ONLY *** in early February.
- All 8th graders will take Living Environment/Biology next year and will take the regents in June
- 9th graders will have the option of taking Chemistry (the accelerated science course) or Earth Science
- AP Curriculums can be viewed on collegeboards.org (click on "AP"). Some colleges will not accept AP courses at all.
- Assoc. Director of Admissions from Gettysburg College, Darrel Jones, will be speaking at the 11th Grade Parent College Planning Meeting on 1/12/12
