DISTRICT ITEMS:

2013-2104 DISTRICT GOALS -ONGOING

- 1. To implement the first phase of personalized learning via the utilization of technological resources which will identify a student's individual learning needs, engage the student in academic goal setting, and provide content, practice and immediate feedback.
- 2. To explore the feasibility of offering online/blended High School elective courses in order to develop competence and confidence in a virtual learning environment.
- To further develop and implement comprehensive curricula in the areas of English Language
 Arts and Mathematics which are fully aligned to the New York State Common Core Learning
 Standards.
- 4. In the second year of Annual Professional Performance Review (APPR) implementation, teachers will revise and refine local measures in order to ensure rigorous, comparable and responsible assessment practices.
- 5. To ensure compliance with the federal "Affordable Care Act" with regard to legal requirements and appropriate financial planning.
- 6. To write, review and/or revise District policies to ensure compliance with the recently enacted legislation and related regulations by the New York State Department of Education, including but not limited to: Annual Professional Performance Review, New York State Assessments, and the New York State Common Core Learning Standards.

TEACHER CONTRACT-6/30/12-ONGOING

Teachers are in their second year without a contract. Negotiation is protracted.

SCHOOL SECURITY: ONGOING:

- 1. Major upgrades are taking place this summer.
- 2. More high resolution cameras are being installed.
- 3. 96 sets of doors at CSHHS will have alarms on doors.
- 4. A renovation of LHS entry will take place. The main office and nurse's office will be moved to create a better visual of building for main office.
- 5. A new alert system is being adopted so top administrators will be contacted immediately of any issues.
- 6. LHS and WSS are participating in the CAPS program for internet safety.

OTHER DISTRICT ITEMS:

- 1. Dr. Wilansky will host Parent Leaders Brunch on Friday, April 25 at 9:30. She will announce new mental health and substance abuse program changes for the district. Dr. Barry Wilansky will be the guest speaker.
- 2. Thursday, April 24 will be the Ed Tech Showcase at the field house from 7-9pm for parents to see technology in education at CSHSD.
- 3. On June 1 there will be a fitness walk with vendors and service providers regarding health issues at the high school in memory of classmate Cody Taddonio.
- 4. Common Core issue is still unsettled. Issue with Pearson not releasing test questions is still unresolved. Pearson may release some test questions.
- 5. CSHSD will be receiving some funds from the Gap Elimination fund.
- 6. School district budget increase is net 2.06 with a tax levy of 1.89.
- 7. Annual budget vote is coming up on Tuesday, May 20.
- 8. Three seats are open on the school board with three candidates running: Janice Elkin, Mark McAteer, and Mark Freidberg.

PARENT ITEMS:

1. Parents have asked district "opt out" numbers. Dr. Wilansky reported 8 students opted out of the state testing.
